COME VISIT OUR PARKS

Bluff & Summit Park

Head west on Main Street to visit this park with spectacular views of the Wet Mountain Valley at the base of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains. Come together has a family or group for a picnic, wedding, or concert here.

Hermit Park

Located on Hermit Road across from Memorial Park. Has tennis courts, a large pavilion with picnic tables, and water and electricity are available. Enjoy a game of soccer, toss the football with some friends or practice your frisbee skills at the multipurpose playing field.

Memorial Park

Located on the block west of Highway 69 between 3rd and 4th street. This park includes a playground for kids to run around and play, two covered pavilions perfect for a picnic, restrooms, a baseball field and a large grassy area for all the activities you would like to take part of.

Jess Price Memorial Park

Currently under construction. Once construction is complete, it will have an improved paver path for smooth foot traffic, seasonal flower beds for vibrant beauty, a new gazebo for community gatherings, additional trees for shade and ambiance, and more seating for relaxation.
