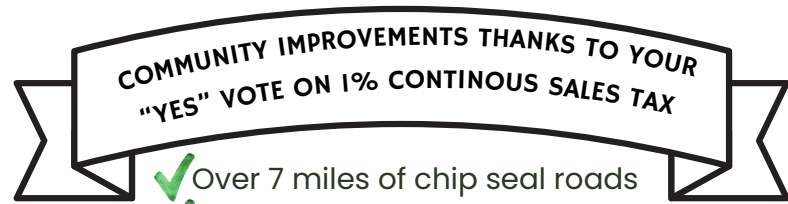

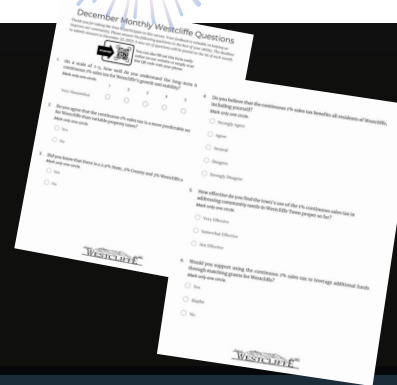

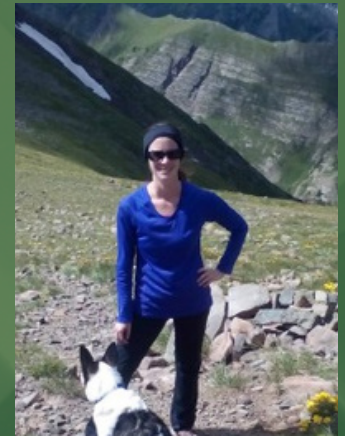
- **2% for General Fund:**
  - Covers utilities for town buildings, street lighting.
  - Pays salaries and benefits for town employees.
  - Maintains streets (pothole repairs, striping) and parks (sprinkler repairs, tree care).
- **1% for Capital Improvements (Approved in 2020):**
  - Funds new construction and repairs: streets, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, alleyways.
  - Enhances parks and town-owned equipment.
  - All projects are approved by the Board of Trustees.
